# BINGO!

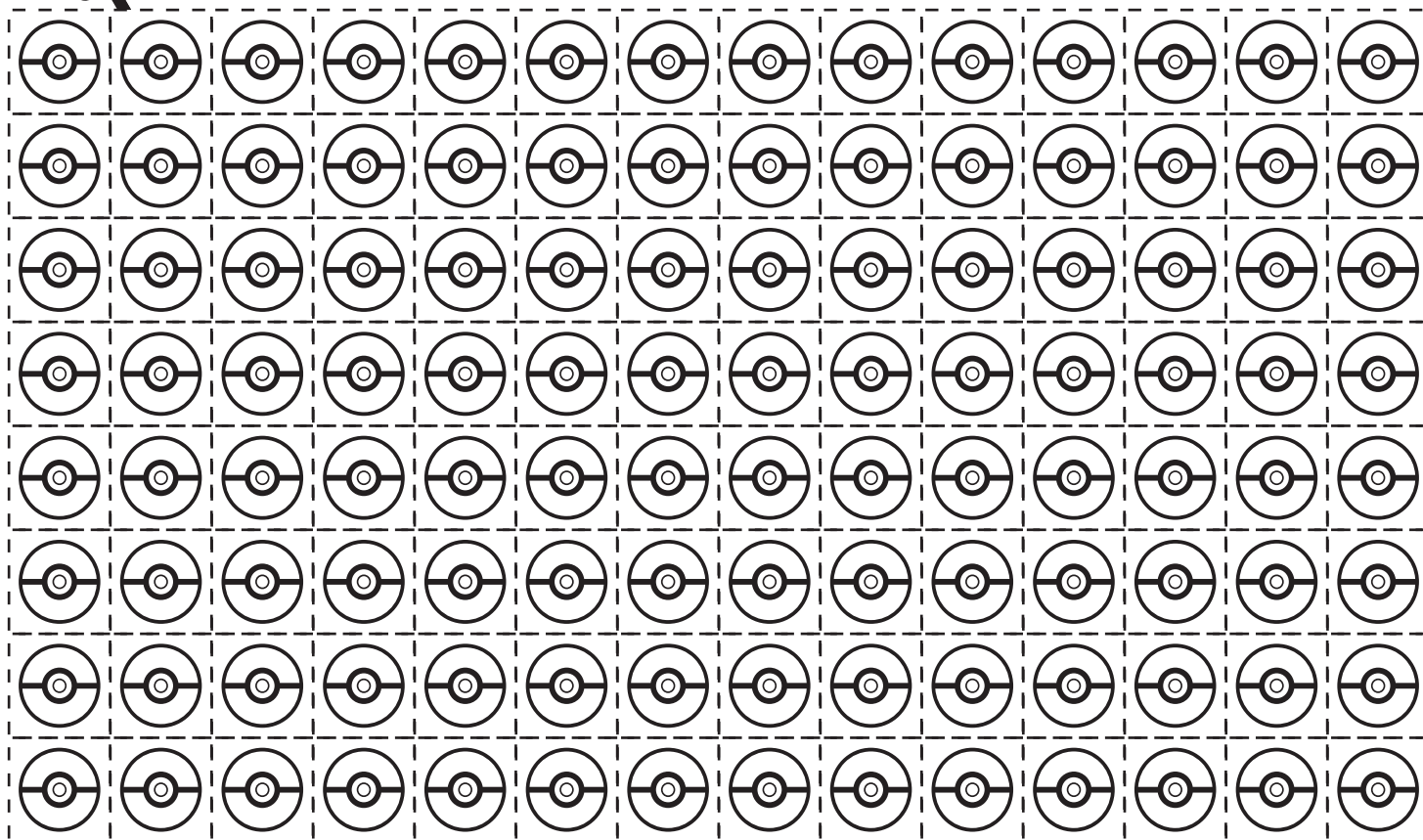
The 2023 Pokémon World Championships are just around the corner. Fans who find themselves watching a live stream of the epic battles between the world's top players can join the fun with printable Pokémon World Championships bingo cards and markers. Watching your favorite Pokémon TCG Trainer face off against a rival? Keep an eye on your bingo card for a chance to mark off a square! Hoping to see your favorite Pokémon make an appearance in Pokémon UNITE? There's a chance it might show up on your bingo card, too! Whether you're looking for something fun to do with friends while watching the drama unfold or simply want something to do with your hands as you root for your favorite Trainers and teams, these bingo sheets have you covered!

## How to Play Pokémon Bingo

1. Download and print the eight unique bingo cards and Poké Ball markers.
2. Cut out the Poké Ball markers from the sheet.
3. Distribute one bingo card and a handful of Poké Ball markers to each player.
4. Start watching the Pokémon World Championships 2023 live stream.
5. When an event or Pokémon on your card appears, mark it by placing a Poké Ball marker on that square.
6. The first player to mark five consecutive squares vertically, horizontally, or diagonally says "bingo" and wins the round!

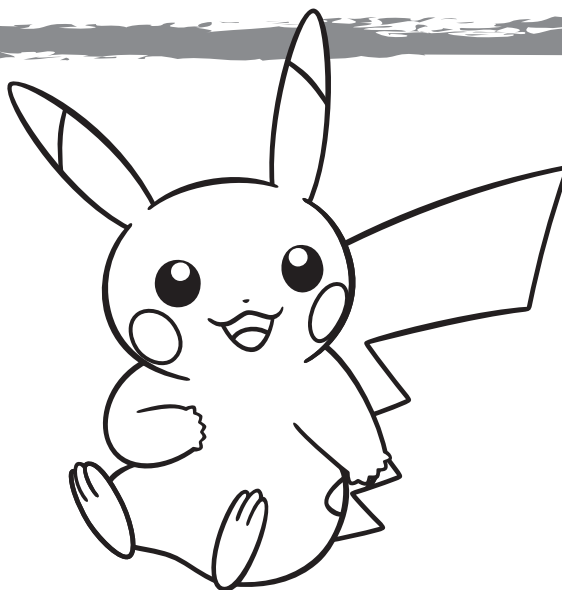

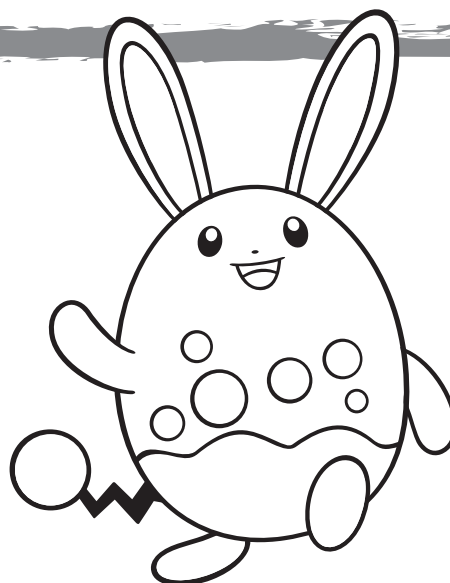
